07/29/2021 Board Meeting held

- New Board members were welcomed and introduced to the CCESGC and its history
- Crystal Abers discussed the various loans that have been funded through the program and funds that are available
- Discussed the recent approval for the CCESGC to establish a Microenterprise Assistance Program
 which is a grant through NY OCR that is aimed to assist startup and established microenterprise
 businesses in Cattaraugus County.

For FY2021:

- 1. Monthly principal and interest payments of \$2,602.31 on a \$269,500.00 business expansion loan continued from January 31, 2021 through December 7, 2021 and totaled \$33,948.08 in 2021.
- 2. Monthly principal and interest payments of \$2,828.59 on \$260,345.00 new business loan continued on August 12, 2021 through December 7, 2021 and totaled \$14,142.95 in 2021.
